


User Guide for beginners



1.Search for books

Search for books by entering a keyword, ISBN, or other terms into the search box.



For more search options, click "Advanced Search" or "Browse Subjects".

Recommend : Creating a Proquest Ebook Central Account


Creating an Proquest Ebook Central account will allow you to download e-books directly to your computer or mobile device. We recommend creating an account first.

*However, you can view it without a personal account.

Click the “Sign In” link at the top right.

In the window that opens, click the “Create an account” link.

Complete the information(your name, institutional email address, and password), agree to eBook Central's terms of service, then click Create Account.(in 30s)



2. How to see Search Results

Search Results

Enter your search term and click the Search button.

On the search results screen you can narrow search results using provided filters at the left.

Click the title to see a book detail page.


